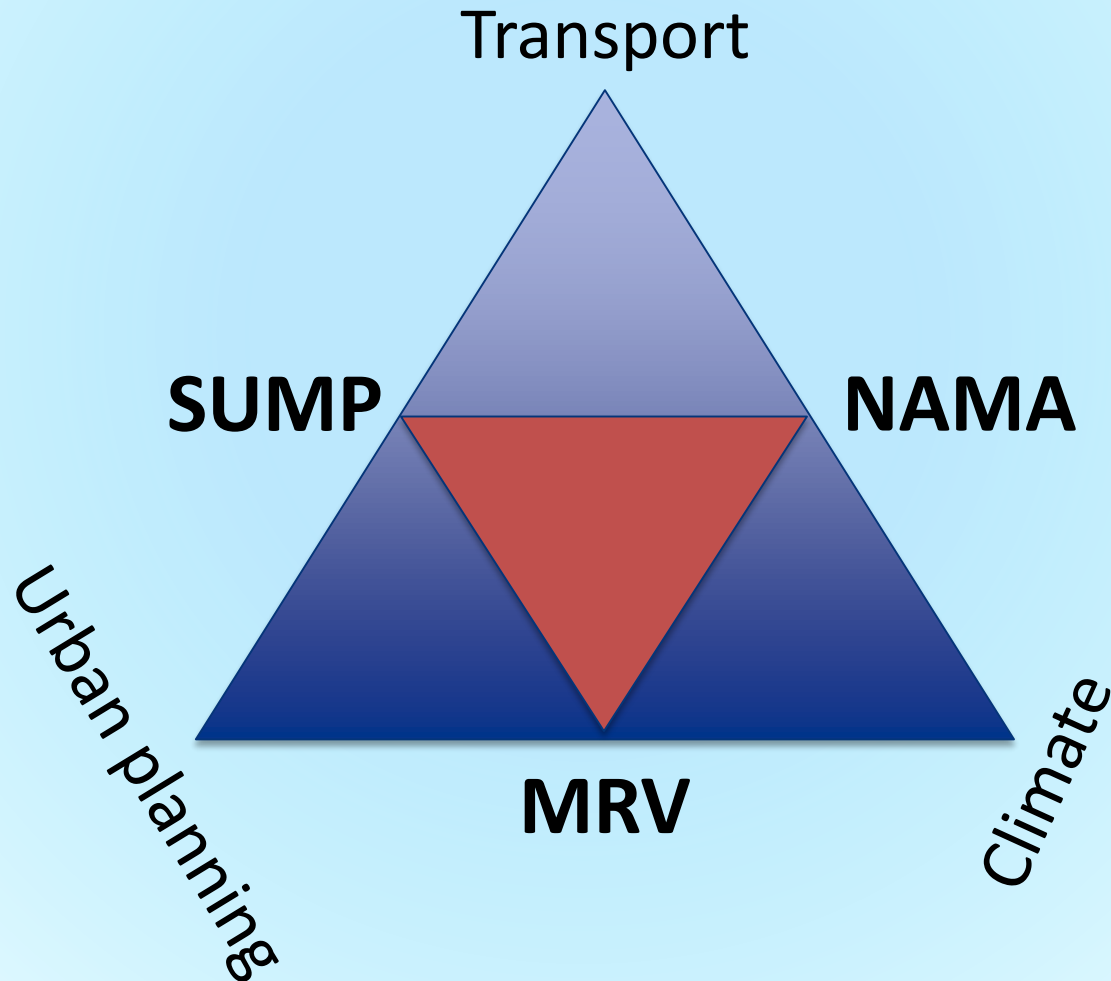
- **Partnerships** (Bridging the Gap & SLoCaT)

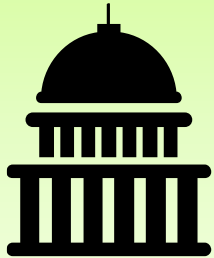

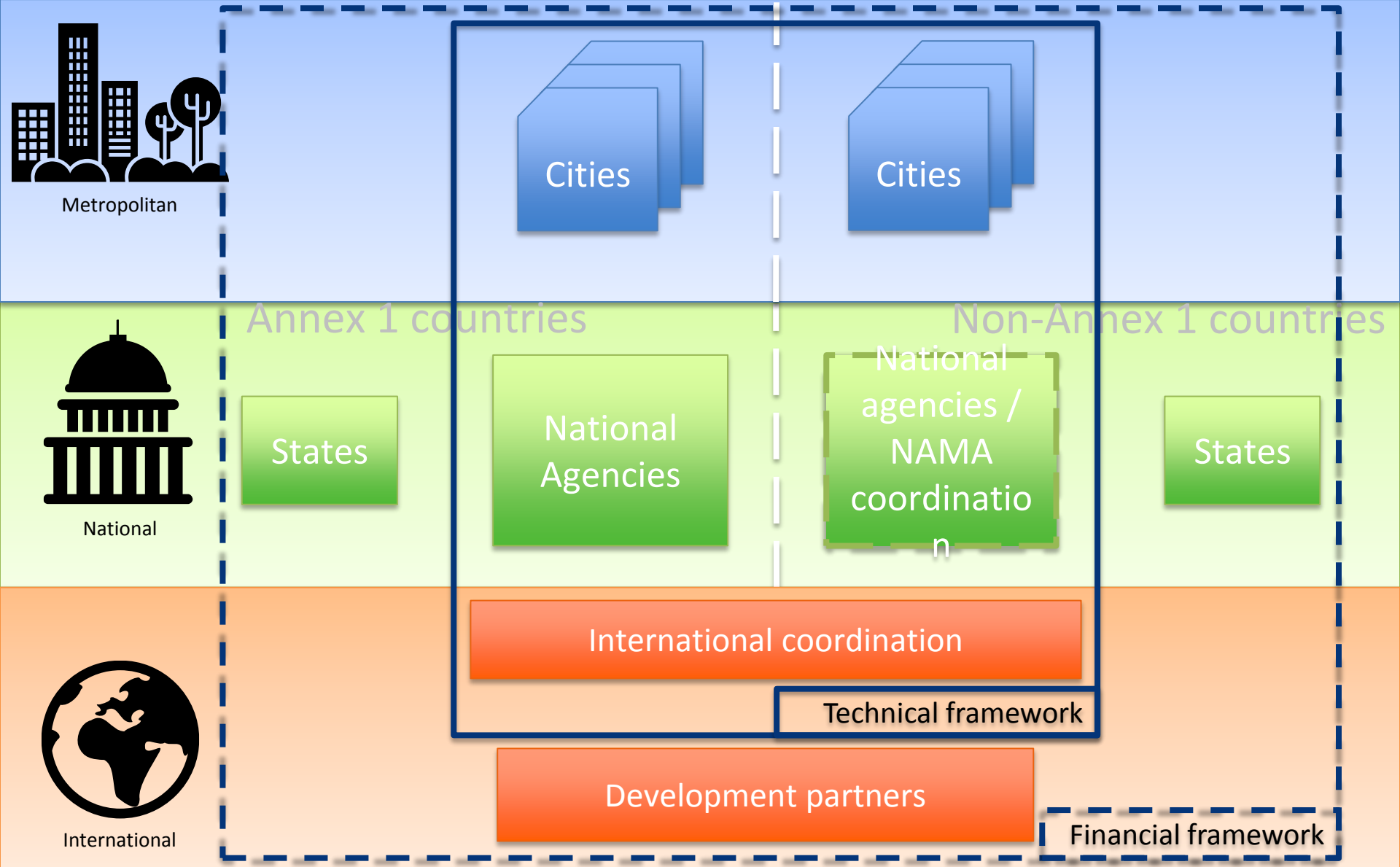

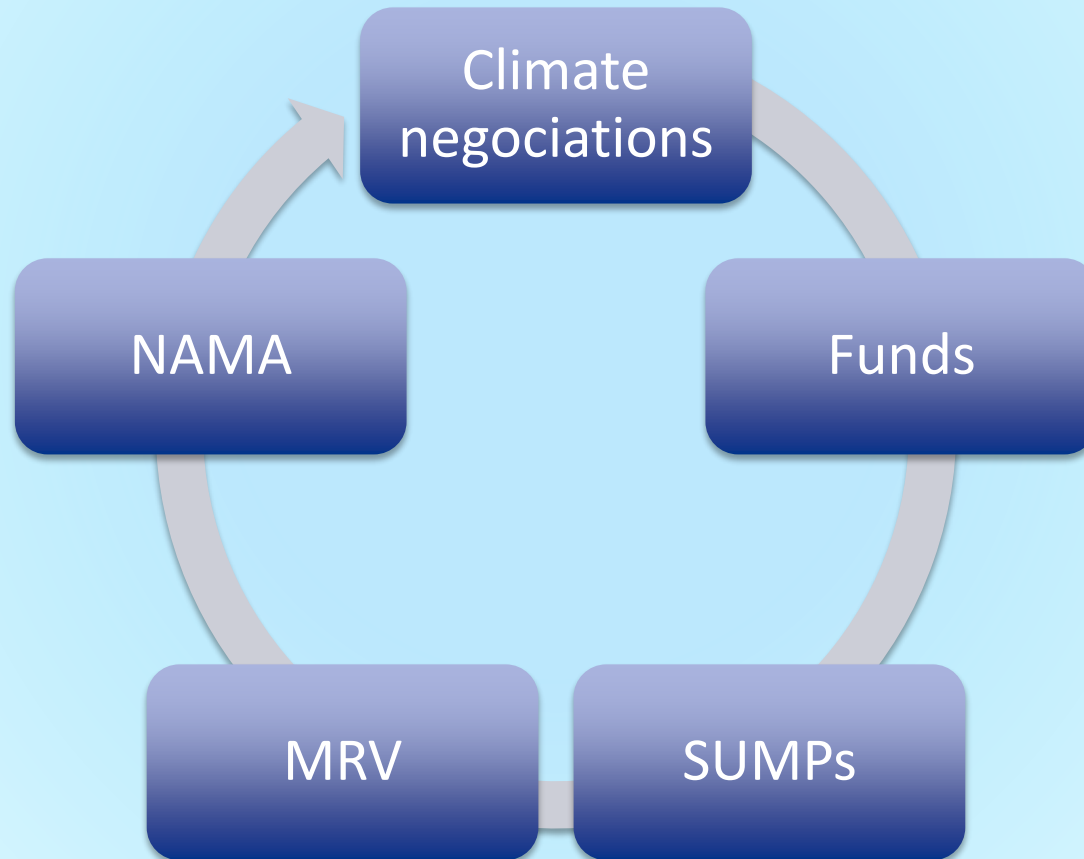
